

Make sure there is parking at both ends of the trail. Harvey Park makes sense but are cars going to line the street outside people's homes on the other end of the trail? Lights are important as well. Safety is a big concern... for the homes backing the trail....

As the project moves forward in the design stage, the City and its consultant will explore opportunities for additional parking in the vicinity. Lighting will be considered at strategic locations for safety. Many of the key locations include connectivity at roadway intersections where the greenway will be accessible to the neighborhoods. The current configuration attempts to maximize the buffer between the greenway and the nearby residential properties in order to discourage users from wandering onto private residential properties.

I would like to see the greenway also extend to the south into the older section of Spring Hill.

Although the federal grant funding secured for this project is for the current project limits, consideration is being given to extensions and/or connections to future greenways. The City's Greenway Plan is available on the City website, <https://www.springhilltn.org/harveyparkgreenway> that illustrates the network of greenway projects proposed throughout the community.

As a resident of Belshire Village I am very excited about this project... anything that can be done to expedite it would be fantastic.

The City and consultants are working with TDOT to ensure all state and federal reviews and approvals are met and will continue to work expeditiously to bring this project to fruition as soon as possible. The City will continue to provide periodic updates on the project as remaining design work continues toward construction of the project.

The City is working with current and proposed developments for inclusion of greenways and the City is also continuing to look for opportunities to expand the greenway network including pursuit of new state and federal grants to supplement local funding.

The City has recently updated the Spring Hill Parks, Recreation and Greenways Master Plan and is tentatively planning to update the Spring Hill Bicycle and Greenway Plan in an effort to provide guidance for planning and construction of future greenways included with both private and public developments.
